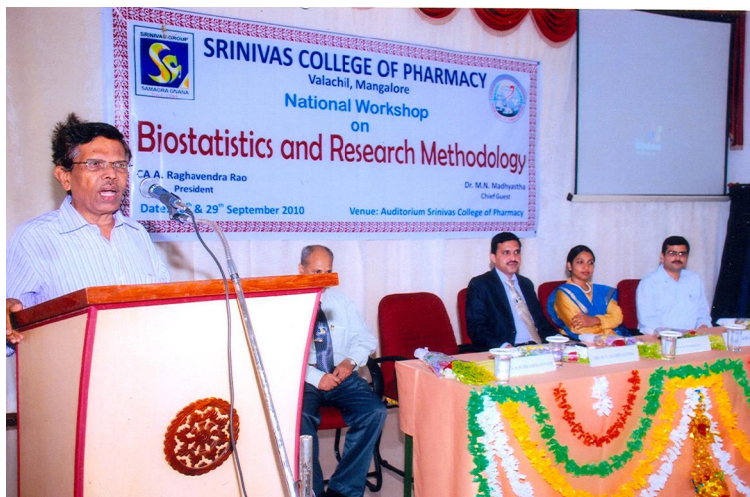
## National Workshop on Biostatistics and Research Methodology
