- **Basic Care and Life Support (BCLS) Training Programme**

In today's world, knowing how to handle a medical emergency is more important than ever. Basic Care Life Support (BCLS) training equips individuals with essential life-saving skills that can significantly improve outcomes in situations such as choking, drowning, cardiac arrest, severe allergic reactions, drug overdoses, and more. Timely CPR alone can double or even triple a victim's chances of survival.

The BCLS course also includes essential first aid measures, management of massive external bleeding, and the safe use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). In accordance with RGUHS guidelines, BCLS training is mandatory for healthcare professionals.

To promote this life-saving knowledge, Srinivas Institute of Dental Sciences, in association with RGUHS Jeevaraksha Trust, organised a comprehensive hands-on BCLS training programme from 15th to 17th July 2025 for interns and postgraduate students.

The event was formally inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Reshma Pai Dean of SIDS, Prof. Dr. Uday Kumar Dean of SIMS &RC, along with senior instructors from Jeevaraksha. In her inaugural address, Prof Dr. Reshma Pai highlighted the importance of BCLS training in developing clinical competency and preparing healthcare providers to manage medical emergencies

effectively. Dr. Rajeeth Shetty, Professor and Head of the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and BCLS Coordinator, introduced the trainers to the attendees.

The training covered a range of critical emergency response skills including Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), relief of airway obstruction in choking victims, management of severe bleeding using improvised tourniquets, and the correct use of an AED. The sessions included instructional videos on emergency scenarios, followed by live demonstrations of the techniques taught.

A total of 84 participants comprising 75 interns and 9 postgraduate students successfully completed the training. By the end of the programme, students expressed confidence and readiness to respond to medical emergencies in both clinical and everyday settings.

Father Mueller college of Allied Health Sciences of Mangalore won the tournament and SDM Naturopathy college, Ujire won the runner up trophy.





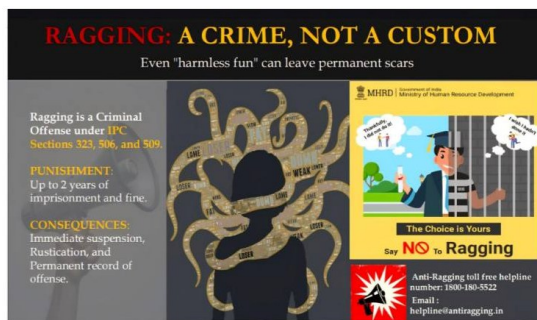
- **ANTI RAGGING DAY and Week-Long Awareness Program (12th August 2025 - 18th August 2025).**

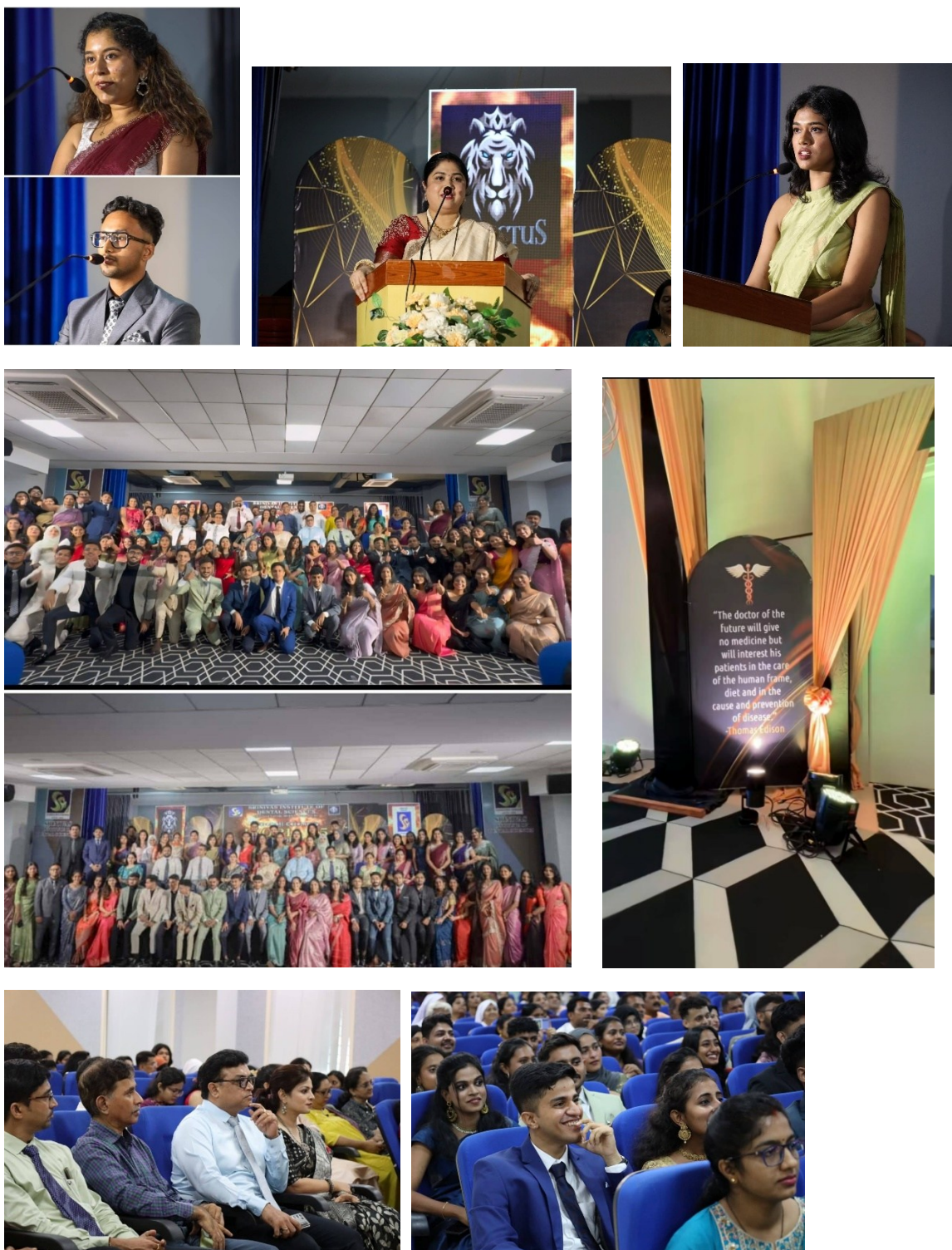

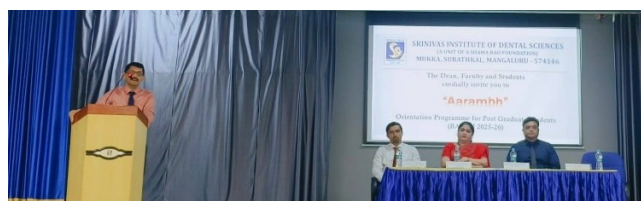
Prof. (Dr.) Praveen Shetty, Head of the Department of Orthodontics, welcomed the gathering.
